

## WGC Match Play 2021 Picks

Match Play picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

**Paul Casey** – Casey has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Casey has two 9<sup>th</sup> place finishes at Match Play over the past 4 years.

**Justin Thomas** – Thomas has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Thomas finished 4<sup>th</sup> at this event in 2018.

**Dustin Johnson** – Johnson has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Johnson won this tourney in 2017.

**Kevin Kisner** – Kisner is the defending champion to go with a 2<sup>nd</sup> in 2018 and a 17<sup>th</sup> in 2017.

**Louis Oosthuizen** – Oosthuizen has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Oosthuizen also has 3 top 10 finishes at Match Play over the past 5 years.

**Matthew Fitzpatrick** – Fitzpatrick has 4 top 15 finishes (3 top 10s) in his most recent 4 events played.

**Tony Finau** – Finau has 3 second place finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

**Jon Rahm** – Rahm has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (3 top 10s). Rahm finished 2<sup>nd</sup> at Match Play in 2017.

**Bryson DeChambeau** – DeChambeau has 2 top 3 finishes in his most recent 2 events played, including a win.

**Max Homa** – Homa has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.
