

Amex 2022 Picks

Amex picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Rahm finished 6th at Amex in 2019 and he won this event in 2018.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. Cantlay has 2 top 10 finishes at this tourney over the past 3 years.

Scottie Scheffler – Scheffler has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Scheffler finished 3rd at this event in 2020.

Matthew Wolff – Wolff has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, 2 top 5s.

Talor Gooch – Gooch has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Gooch has 3 top 25 finishes at Amex over the past 3 years.

Corey Connors – Connors is trending coming into this event to go with 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Seamus Power – Power has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Power finished 11th at this tourney in 2018.

Sungjae Im – Im has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Im has 3 top 15 finishes at this event.

Abraham Ancer – Ancer has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Ancer finished top 5 at Amex over the past 2 years.

Siwoo Kim – Kim is the defending champion.
