

BMW 2022 Picks

BMW picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Tony Finau – Finau has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including 2 wins. Finau has 4 top 10 finishes at BMW over the past 5 years.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Cantlay is the defending champion.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Rahm has 4 top 10 finishes at BMW over the past 5 years, including a win in 2020.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. McIlroy has 2 top 5 finishes at this event over the past 4 years.

Xander Schauffele – Schauffele has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins. Schauffele finished 3rd at this tourney in 2018.

Sungjae Im – Im has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including 2 second finishes. Im finished 3rd at BMW last year.

Cameron Young – Young has 2 second place finishes in his most recent 3 events played.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is trending coming into this event. Thomas won this event in 2019.

Joohyung Kim – Kim has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win.

Scott Stallings – Stallings has 5 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.
