

Canadian Open 2022 Picks

Canadian Open picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Scottie Scheffler – Scheffler has 2 wins and a second-place finish in his most recent 5 events played. It's his first Canadian Open.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played (3 top 10s). McIlroy is the defending champion.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Thomas finished 20th at Canadian in 2019.

Sam Burns – Burns has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins.

Matt Fitzpatrick – Fitzpatrick has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played.

Shane Lowry – Lowry has 2 top 3 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Lowry finished 2nd at this event in 2019 and he finished 12th in 2018.

Tony Finau – Finau has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Finau finished 5th at this tourney in 2017.

Tyrrell Hatton – Hatton has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Hatton is on a trend coming into Canadian with a 13th finish in his most recent event played.

Corey Connors – Connors has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Connors is on a trend coming into this event with a 13th finish in his most recent event played.

Cameron Smith – Smith has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.
