

Fortinet 2022 Picks

Fortinet picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Max Homa – Homa is the defending champion, he is on a trend coming into Fortinet and he finished 3rd in his most recent event played.

Taylor Montgomery – Montgomery has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Taylor Pendrith – Pendrith has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is trending coming into this event. Pendrith finished 36th at this tourney last year.

Brendan Steele – Steele won this event in 2017 and in 2018. Steele is trending coming into this tourney with a 32nd finish in his most recent event played.

Cameron Davis – Davis has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Davis finished 17th at Fortinet in 2018.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama is trending with a 9th finish in his most recent event played. Matsuyama finished 6th at this tourney last year.

Justin Suh – Suh has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win in his most recent event played. Suh finished 58th at this event last year.

Emiliano Grillo – Grillo has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 second place finishes.

Sahith Theegala – Theegala has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Theegala finished 14th at Fortinet in 2020.

Will Gordon – Gordon is on a trend coming into this event with a 26th finish in his most recent event played, to go along with 3 top 5s, including a win in his most recent 5 events played.
