

John Deere 2022 Picks

John Deere picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Sahith Theegala – Theegala has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played.

Nick Hardy – Hardy has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Hardy has 2 top 55 finishes at John Deere, coming in 2017 and 2018.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 2 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Chez Reavie – Reavie has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Reavie finished 18th at this tourney last year.

Lucas Glover – Glover is the defending champion. Glover has not missed a cut in his most recent 4 events played.

Denny McCarthy – McCarthy has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. McCarthy finished 34th at John Deere in 2018.

Scott Brown – Brown finished 10th in his most recent event played. Brown has 3 top 25 finishes at this event over the past 5 years.

Adam Schenk – Schenk has 2 top 30 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Schenk has 2 top 10 finishes at this tourney over the past 3 years. (2020 John Deere was canceled.)

J.T. Poston – Poston has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, 2nd last week at Travelers.

Scott Stallings – Stallings has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Stallings finished 5th at John Deere in 2017 and he was 18th in 2019.
