Mexico Open picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Mark Hubbard – Hubbard has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Jon Rahm – Rahm 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is the highest ranked player in the field at number 2 in the OWGR.

Gary Woodland – Woodland has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Sebastian Munoz – Munoz has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Munoz is also on a slight trend coming into this tourney.

Nate Lashley – Lashley has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Cameron Tringale – Tringale has 2 top 35 finishes in his most recent 2 events played and he is trending coming into this event.
