

Valspar 2022 Picks

Valspar picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Viktor Hovland – Hovland has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Hovland finished 3rd at Valspar last year.

Tyrrell Hatton – Hatton has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (3 top 10s).

Shane Lowry – Lowry has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Thomas finished 13th at Valspar last year.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played and he is on a trend coming into Valspar. Johnson finished 6th at this event in 2019.

Matt Fitzpatrick – Fitzpatrick has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Collin Morikawa – Morikawa has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (2 top 10s).

Xander Schauffele – Schauffele has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Keegan Bradley – Bradley is trending coming into Valspar with 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 2 events played, including 5th at the Players. Bradley finished 2nd at Valspar last year.

Abraham Ancer – Ancer is on a trend coming into this event with a 33rd finish at the Players. Ancer finished 5th at Valspar last year and he finished 16th in 2018.
