

WGC Match Play 2022 Picks

Match Play picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Scottie Scheffler – Scheffler has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including 2 wins. Scheffler finished 2nd at his first Match Play last year.

Matt Fitzpatrick – Fitzpatrick has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Fitzpatrick has 2 top 20 finishes at this event over the past 5 years.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 top 10s. Rahm has 2 top 5 finishes at this tourney over the past 5 years.

Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Thomas finished 4th at Match Play in 2018.

Kevin Kisner – Kisner has 1 top 5 finish in his most recent 2 events played. Kisner has 4 top 20 finishes at Match Play over the past 5 years, including a win and a 2nd.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Cantlay has 3 top 25 finishes at this event over the past 4 years.

Daniel Berger – Berger has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Berger finished 18th at this tourney last year.

Joaquin Niemann – Niemann has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. His most recent finish was 22nd. Niemann finished 18th at Match Play last year.

Viktor Hovland – Hovland has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Shane Lowry – Lowry has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Lowry finished 24th at this event in 2019.
